Federally Funded Research in Hawaii

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Hawaii from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in [Hawaii](#) received 86 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$54,427,971.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in [Hawaii](#) received 118 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$45,649,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in [Hawaii](#) received research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$1,802,000.

Companies Created from Research in Hawaii

The Science Coalition's Sparking Economic Growth [reports](#) identify nearly 200 companies created as a result of federally funded university research across the country. These companies are bringing transformative innovations in energy, medicine, defense and technology to the market; creating new jobs and boosting local economies; and succeeding at rates far greater than most new businesses in the United States.
