Federally Funded Research in Mississippi

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Mississippi from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in Mississippi received 89 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$53,538,828.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in Mississippi received 76 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$32,332,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in <u>Mississippi</u> received research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$1,238,000.

Companies Created from Research in Mississippi

Verari Systems began in 1996 in a Mississippi State University Incubator as MPI Software. MPI grew to over 40 employees before being acquired in 2004 and becoming the software division of Verari Systems, providing high-performance solutions for managing parallel and cluster computers.

Spatial Information Solutions is a start-up company based on several Mississippi State University technologies from the GeoResources Institute. The company has developed a series of specialized software tools for remote sensing and spatial information technology used in critical applications such as 911 emergency response and disaster planning.
