### Federally Funded Research in Nevada

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Nevada from three of the major government research agencies:

#### National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in [Nevada](#) received 55 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$31,316,007.

#### National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in [Nevada](#) received 84 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$15,872,000.

#### Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in [Nevada](#) benefitted from research awards from the DOE office of Science totaling \$3,676,520.

### Companies Created from Research in Nevada

[DxDiscovery](#), founded in 2013 by University of Nevada professors Tom Kozel and David AuCoin, is a developer of medical diagnostics tests for infectious diseases. The company is currently developing biomarkers for early diagnosis of invasive candidiasis, a common bloodstream infection.
