Federally Funded Research in Pennsylvania

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Pennsylvania from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Pennsylvania</u> received 3,464 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$1,570,151,520.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Pennsylvania</u> received 1,025 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$275,327,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in Pennsylvania received research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$37,322,078.
