Federally Funded Research in South Carolina

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in South Carolina from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>South Carolina</u> received 432 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$179,069,761.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>South Carolina</u> received 164 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$60,842,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in <u>South</u> <u>Carolina</u> received research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$4,021,888.
