See the impact of funding to organizations in Iowa from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in lowa received 415 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$170,060,863.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in lowa received 203 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$59,211,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in Iowa received research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$10,003,182.
