Federally Funded Research in Maine

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Maine from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Maine</u> received 114 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$75,619,398.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Maine</u> received 71 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$17,104,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

During 2014, educational organizations in Maine benefitted from DOE Office of Science research awards worth \$30,000.
